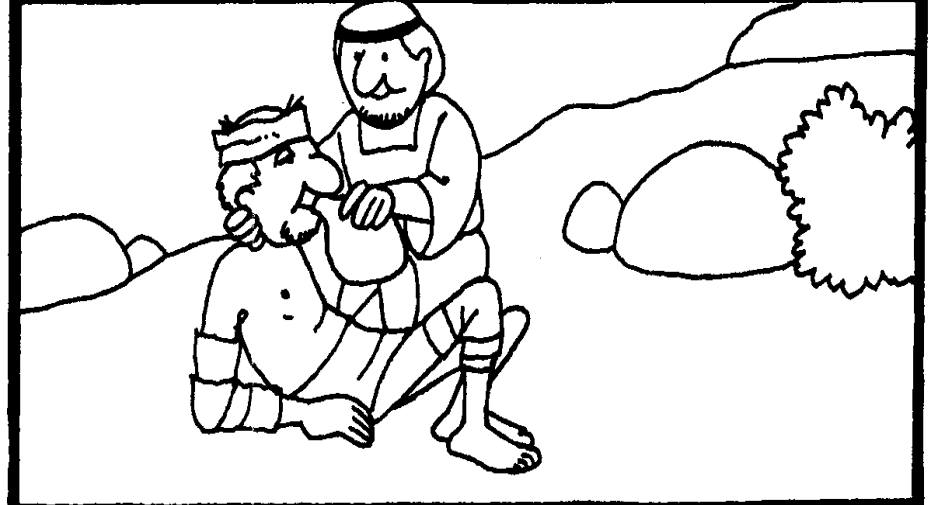


Love your neighbour as you love yourself
