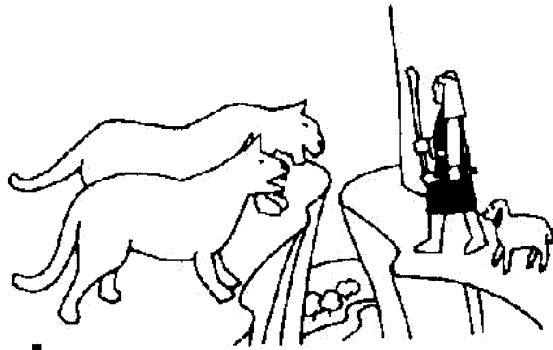

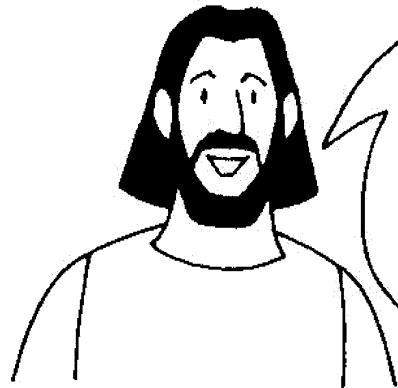
Jesus saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

He kept in close touch with his Father in heaven, praying every day - lots. Also, he could see the needs of the people. So he met their needs.

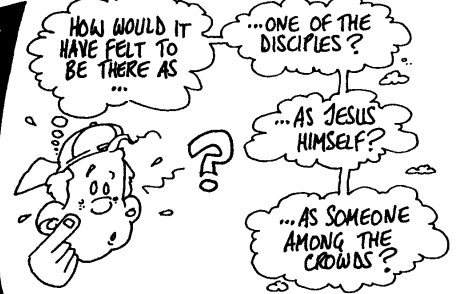
IT MUST HAVE BEEN SO AMAZING TO BE THERE WHEN JESUS WAS AT WORK.

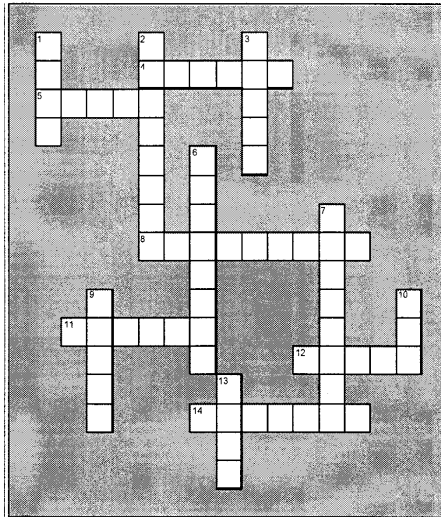

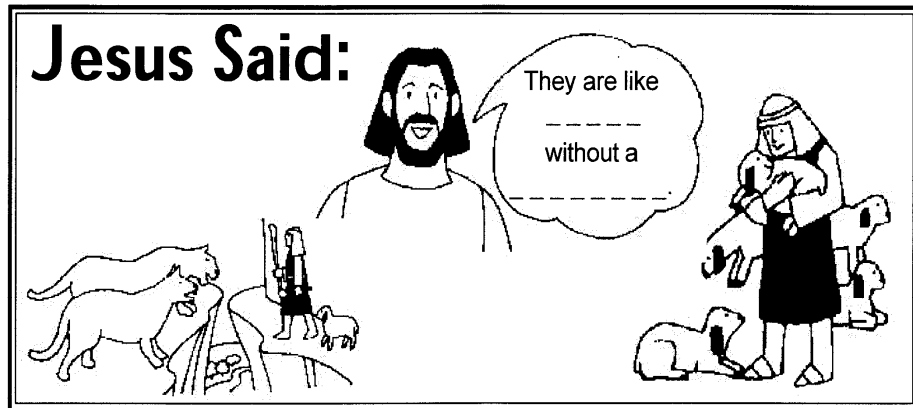
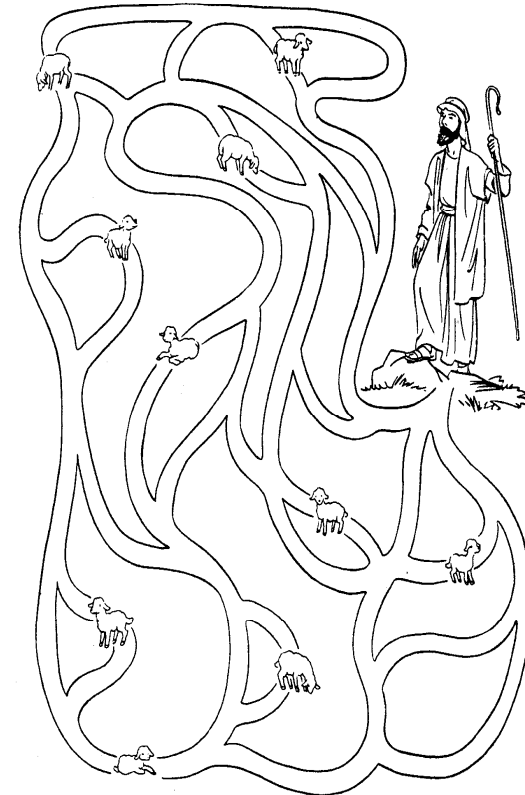
Jesus was like a shepherd with his sheep.

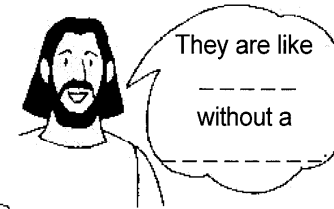
